**SACRED STITCHES: HISTORIC VESTMENT EXHIBIT AT THE BASILICA:** *Some of the historic vestments from the Basilica's collection will be on display in the temporary exhibit space, from April 1 – September 27, 2009. The exhibit includes James Cardinal Gibbons' golden vestments, which he wore during the Third Plenary Council in 1884; a set of Irish Poplin vestments from the bishop and clergy of the Diocese of Ardagh and Clonmacnoise, to Archbishop Michael J. Curley, which feature stunning hand-stitched Celtic designs; along with several other beautiful and historic vestments.*
