**From our pastor, Msgr. Cramblitt....**

THREE SUNDAYS OF FEASTS: The great season of the Church (the Lent/Easter season) came to its conclusion last Sunday at the Pentecost feast. Now we have returned to Ordinary Time. However there are now three Sundays of great feasts in a row, so Ordinary Time will not be so ordinary for a while. Today is Trinity Sunday. Next Sunday is the feast of the Body and Blood of Christ, also known as Corpus Christi, and the Sunday after that we will celebrate the feast of the Sacred Heart. This trio of feasts always comes at the conclusion of the Easter season and they are a way of helping us to celebrate the love of God, the Lord's abiding presence with us and the unfailing care of the Lord Jesus for us.

When great things happen in life we always want to linger over the cause of our joy. So it is in the cycle of feasts and seasons of the Church. The great thing we have just encountered is the paschal mystery of Jesus' death and resurrection, and the gift of the Holy Spirit. We are forgiven! Eternal life has been restored to us! Hope is in our hearts! God's Spirit is there to guide us! It would be impossible for a believer to just end the season of joy and walk away from it. No! We want to linger with the marvelous love of God. And so we have these feasts. Enjoy them. Allow them to penetrate your heart.

**POOR BOX FOR JUNE: CAMP ST. VINCENT:** Camp St. Vincent is a summer day camp for children from households experiencing homelessness or poverty in Baltimore City and County. At Camp St. Vincent, children ages 6 to 10 are given the opportunity to experience the joys of two weeks at summer camp in the open space and fresh air of the countryside. The children who attend are nominated from

Baltimore area schools, churches, and social service agencies, and are accepted into the program without regard to race, religion, or nationality. Over 60% of the children who attend are homeless. Camp St. Vincent offers a structured outdoor recreation program. The children also participate in daily Values Development Lessons, which strive to boost self-esteem and encourage resistance to negative peer pressure. This is an atmosphere where sharing, cooperation, fairness, and respect are emphasized.
