Question for Adults

REGISTER NOW TO VOTE IN 2010 ELECTIONS: *You must be registered in order to vote in this fall's elections, which will include races for governor, U.S. House and Senate, and the Maryland General Assembly. Basic requirements include being an American citizen, Maryland resident and at least 18 years old by the next general election. The deadline to register to vote in Maryland's primary election is Tuesday, August 24.
